### Call for project proposals

## **For the Programme of preservation, reconstruction and public access of the immovable cultural heritage of the Zlin Region launched by Zlin region, the intermediary of the Programme**

**1. Referential Number:** CZ0024

**2. The Programme is financed by the EEA Financial Mechanism (42,5%), the Norwegian Financial mechanism (42,5%) and the Zlin region (15%)**

### **3. Activities, focus area and duration of the projects**

(a) The aim of the Programme is to support the projects of preservation, reconstruction of objects of cultural heritage in the region and opening them up to the public. The project should focus on archaeological heritage and the heritage of folk building craft and related objects, aiming to its conservation and opening them to the broad public. This to be done by:

- Reconstruction of the immovable objects of cultural heritage
- Constructing places where the cultural heritage could be exhibited, the project should respect especially children, young people and disabled people.
- Realizing new forms of presentation of the cultural heritage aiming at educating people about our ancestors' ways and conditions of living

(b) Focus area: Zlín region

(c) Maximum duration of the projects: 24 months

**4. Total amount available for the Call:** 705 882 EUR (19 807 050 CZK)

### **5. Maximum and minimum amount of grant:**

(a) Minimum amount of grant for 1 project: 200 000 EUR (5 612 000 CZK)

(b) Maximum amount of grant for 1 project: 250 000 EUR (7 015 000 CZK)

(The approved and reimbursed sum of grant will be always rounded down to whole hundreds)

(c) Maximum percentage of eligible costs paid from the Programme is 85%.

(Exchange rate used for the conversion of currencies: 1 EUR = 28,06 CZK)

## 6. Eligible Applicants for the grant:

Eligible applicants are legal bodies established in the Czech Republic as follows:

- Organisational unit of the state administration
- Allowance organisation established by a state organisational unit
- Regional administration
- Corporation managed or founded by a regional administration (regional administration must be a majority owner)
- Municipality
- Alliance of municipalities
- Corporation managed or founded by a municipality (the municipality must be a majority owner)

## 8. Submission of applications

Applications will be processed on a standard “Application form” enclosed to the “Applicant instructions” and must be signed by an authorised representative. The application form and applicant instructions for filling out the form should be followed precisely.

Complete application must be submitted in 3 printed copies (1 original and 2 copies), including all supporting documents.

Applications should be delivered to the address: Zlin Region, Department of Grants and Programmes, Tř. T. Bati 21, 761 90 Zlín.

Applications must be submitted in a sealed envelope.

There should be the referential number of the Call for the proposal, complete identification of the applicant, address of the applicant and clearly visible text: "Do not open before the meeting of the commission for opening envelopes"

The submitted application should contain the Application form and required documents.

## 9. Date of launching and the Deadline

**Date of launching the Call for proposals: 24.10.2007**

**The deadline for submission of applications: 14.1.2008 12:00 o'clock.** Applications should be delivered to the address mentioned at Art.8 before the deadline. Applications delivered after the deadline will be automatically rejected.

In case an Application is found to be incomplete or relevant documents are missing during the opening the envelopes , the applicant will be invited to complete it. If the missing documents are not provided within 4 working days after delivery of the requirement of the completion, the application will be refused due to incompleteness.
